

VCE Vocational Major and Victorian Pathways Certificate Credit arrangements 2024

This fact sheet outlines the credit arrangements for students continuing or transitioning to the VCE Vocational Major (VM) or Victorian Pathways Certificate (VPC) in 2024.

The VCAL certificate's accreditation period will end in 2023.

Credit arrangements

In 2024, students will receive credit into their VCE VM or VPC certificate for VCAL, VCE and VET units they have completed in or prior to 2023.

Students who have completed Foundation, Intermediate, or Senior VCAL units prior to 2024 will receive a credit as per the table at right.

VCAL Units achieved in 2023 or prior	2024 VPC and VCE Units
Foundation VCAL	VPC credit
Intermediate VCAL	VCE Units 1 or 2
Senior VCAL	VCE Units 3 or 4

VCAL Intermediate and Senior units are not available for enrolment or delivery from 2024



Credit arrangements for the VPC and/or VCE VM

Credit arrangements for students enrolled in the VCAL in 2023 or earlier who transition to the VCE VM or VPC in 2024 are detailed below.

Students who partially completed Foundation VCAL prior to 2024



In 2024, these students:

- may enrol in the VPC and receive credit for completed units in accordance with the credit arrangements described in **Table 1**; or
- may enrol in the VCE or VCE VM with credit for completed units in accordance with the credit arrangements described in **Tables 2, 3 and 4** for any completed:
 - VCE units
 - VET units at Certificate II level or above

Students who completed Intermediate VCAL in 2023



In 2024, these students may enrol in the VCE or VCE VM.

They will be eligible for the award of the VCE VM if they satisfactorily complete:

- a Unit 3–4 sequence from the English group
- three other Unit 3–4 sequences
- 2 Units of PDS, WRS and Numeracy (or any study from the Mathematics group)
- Unit 3–4 sequences for 2024 can be obtained using unit combinations described in **Table 4** or via any VCE, VCE VM or VCE VET approved Unit 3–4 sequence.

Students who partially completed Intermediate VCAL in 2023



In 2024, these students:

- may enrol in the VCE or VCE VM and receive credit for completed units according to the credit arrangements described in **Tables 2, 3 and 4**
- must complete the minimum satisfactory completion requirements of the VCE VM (see QR code below)

VCE Unit 3–4 sequences can be obtained using unit combinations described in Table 4 or via any VCE, VCE VM or VCE VET approved Unit 3–4 sequence.

Students who partially completed Senior VCAL prior to 2024



These students:

- may enrol in the VCE or VCE VM in 2023 and receive credit for completed units according to the credit arrangements described in **Tables 2, 3 and 4**
- must complete the minimum satisfactory completion requirements of the VCE VM (see QR code below)

VCE Unit 3–4 sequences for 2023 can be obtained using unit combinations described in Table 4 or via any VCE, VCE VM or VCE VET approved Unit 3–4 sequence.
