#### TEXT 3A

##### Aplikasi Smartfon Makanan Online



Kini ada fenomena baru di dunia makanan di Indonesia – berkat pengaruh teknologi, masyarakat Indonesia bisa menggunakan aplikasi smartfon untuk memesan makanan lewat internet, bahkan 24 jam setiap hari. Proses pemesanan ini menjadi makin populer bagi warga Indonesia.

Ada salah satu layanan pesan-antar makanan bernama ‘CepatMakan’ dengan banyak pilihan. Mereka bekerjasama dengan lebih dari 300 000 penjual makanan. Tahun lalu saja ‘CepatMakan’ mengirimkan lebih dari 500 juta pesanan di seluruh negeri. Aplikasi smartfon ‘CepatMakan’ menghemat waktu dan mudah dipakai. Pembeli bisa membayar dengan uang tunai langsung kepada pengantar makanan, atau membayar dengan kartu kredit online. Hal ini sangat bermanfaat bagi siswa yang orang tuanya masih di kantor serta atau orang yang bekerja lembur.

Akan tetapi Ibu Vina Laksmana, seorang ahli gizi di Fakultas Kesehatan Perguruan Tinggi Bandung, kuatir bahwa rumah makan tradisional dan warung kecil tidak akan dapat bersaing dengan fenomena baru ini. Kata Bu Vina ‘memesan makanan di internet mengancam kebiasaan berjalan-jalan di pasar malam atau memilih makanan dari pedagang kaki lima. Selain itu, kalau orang merasa malas memasak di rumah, mereka tidak akan berbelanja di pasar untuk daging, buah dan sayuran. Akibatnya, penjual di pasar mungkin akan kehilangan pendapatan. Lagipula, jika lelah dan lapar, kita cenderung memilih makanan cepat saji seperti gorengan yang berlemak yang biasanya diiklankan dengan harga diskon di media massa termasuk aplikasi smartfon makanan online’. Yang lebih menguatirkan Ibu Vina generasi muda ini tidak akan belajar cara memasak dengan baik. Mereka akan lebih sering memilih membeli makanan dari luar daripada memasak sendiri di rumah.

Ibu Vina juga kuatir tentang penggunaan dan kemasan plastik yang dipakai dalam pengiriman makanan. ‘Ini menambah jumlah sampah yang akan dibuang,’ katanya. ‘Kalau kita makan di restoran, warung atau di rumah, piring, sendok dan gelasnya bisa dicuci dan digunakan berulang kali. Ini lebih ramah lingkungan.’

Suasana pasar ini menunjukkan kekayaan kebudayaan Indonesia, Belanda, Tionghoa dan India. Ini tercermin dari bentuk sejumlah bangunan bergaya Tionghoa dan kolonial Belanda seperti gerbang depan pasar ini.

Sepanjang Jalan Pasar Baru bebas kendaraan, jadi Anda bisa bersantai keluar masuk toko-toko yang menjual tekstil dan mode pakaian tradisional dan modern dengan harga murah. Pedagang di sana senang tawar-menawar dengan turis dan mutu barangnya cukup tinggi.
